Ball in a Water Hazard

Rule 26-1. Penalty: one (1) stroke.

In order to treat a ball as "lost in a hazard" there must be reasonable evidence that the ball actually went into the hazard. If no evidence exists, the ball shall be treated as a lost ball (Rule 27). Regular water hazards are marked by yellow lines or stakes, Lateral water hazards are marked by red lines or stakes.

Options:

1. Play a ball from the same spot as the original.
2. Drop a ball as far behind the hazard as you like as long as you keep the point at which the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard in a direct line with the flagstick.

If the ball is in a lateral water hazard 2 additional options are available:

- a) Drop within two club lengths of the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard (not nearer to the hole).
- b) Drop at a point on the opposite margin of the hazard equidistant from the hole.

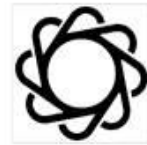
