**If You're Not Playing By The Rules...
You're Not Playing Golf!**

Ball Unplayable -- Rule 28.

Penalty: one (1) stroke.

A player may declare his ball unplayable at any place on the course except when the ball lies in a water hazard. The player is the sole judge as to whether or not the ball is unplayable. The player shall take one of the following options under penalty of one stroke:

1. Play another ball from the spot as near as possible from which the original ball was played.
2. Drop a ball within two club-lengths of the spot where the ball lay, but not nearer the hole.
3. Drop a ball behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point directly in a straight line between the hole and the place where the ball is dropped. There is no limit to how far back the ball may be dropped.

If the unplayable ball lies in a bunker, the same options apply, except that under options 2 or 3 the ball must be dropped in the bunker.
